Colon cancer is one of the most preventable cancers and yet in the United States, colorectal cancer is the third leading cause of cancer-related deaths in men and in women, and the second most common cause of cancer deaths when men and women are combined. It's expected to cause about 51,020 deaths during 2019. According to the American Cancer Society overall, the lifetime risk of developing colorectal cancer is: about 1 in 22 (4.49%) for men and 1 in 24 (4.15%) for women. This risk is slightly lower in women than in men.

The death rate (the number of deaths per 100,000 people per year) from colorectal cancer has been dropping in both men and women for several decades. There are a number of likely reasons for this. One is that colorectal polyps are now being found more often by screening and removed before they can develop into cancers or are being found earlier when the disease is easier to treat. In addition, treatment for colorectal cancer has improved over the last few decades. As a result, there are now more than 1 million survivors of colorectal cancer in the United States. Although the overall death rate has continued to drop, deaths from colorectal cancer among people younger than age 55 have increased 1% per year from 2007 to 2016.

For the past decade, we at Colon Screening for Life along with our many other community sponsors have worked to increase the number of survivors by continuing to educate people on the importance of early detection and the prevention of colon cancer by regular screenings with events like the Colon Screening for Life Boxer 5K Run/Walk and 1 Mile Walk, and our annual March event.

The Colon Screening for Life 5k event will be held on June 8, 2019 at Old National Bank Downtown.
